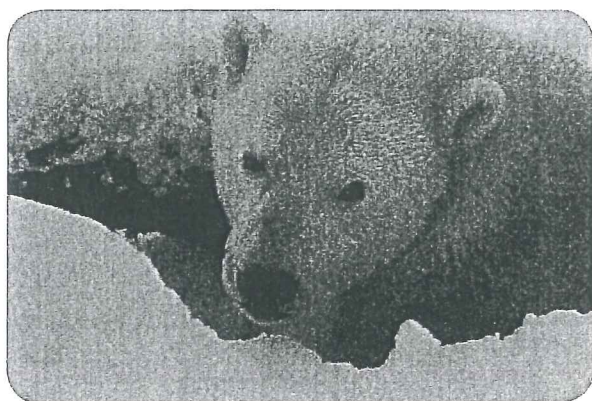

lived in Edinburgh Zoo with a male polar bear, Barney. They had two cubs, To-Nuik and Ohoto. After Barney died, Mercedes lived on her own for fifteen years. She was sad so they built her a special place to live in a wildlife park in the Scottish mountains. She went there in 2009. She now lives outside in an environment which is similar to her native environment and she has a large natural pool to swim in. It snows a lot in winter there so Mercedes is very happy. Last winter she often played in the snow! Mercedes is now 27 years old and she weighs 291 kilos!

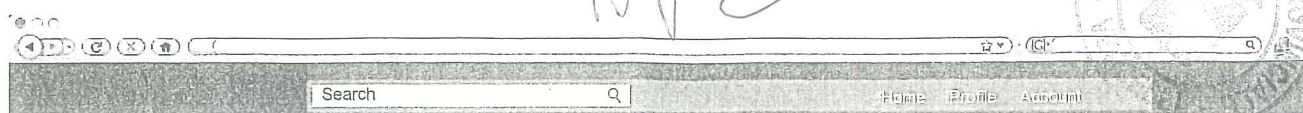

A very long cycle ride

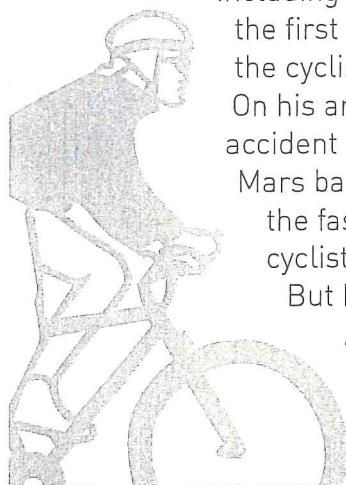
Mark Beaumont is Scottish. He loves cycling long distances. When he was twelve years old, he cycled across Scotland from east to west and a few years later, when he was fifteen, he cycled 1,610 km down Britain from north to south. On that trip his parents followed him in the car. His next long-distance ride took him through Italy, a journey of 2,150 km. He used that trip to raise £50,000 for **charity**.

He became famous in 2008, when he cycled around the world. In August 2007 he left Paris and on 15th February 2008 – 194 days and 17 hours later – he arrived back in the French capital. On the way he cycled 28,968 km passing through 20 countries including Pakistan, Australia, New Zealand and the United States. He wasn't the first person to cycle around the world but he was 81 days faster than the cyclist before him and he set a new Guinness Record.

On his around-the-world trip Mark had a lot of problems. He had an accident in the USA and in the Australian desert he had no food except Mars bars. Why did he do it? He says, «I love the idea of being the first and the fastest!» However, he wasn't the fastest for long. In 2009 another cyclist cycled around the world and completed the ride in only 171 days.

But Mark wasn't discouraged. In 2010 he cycled from Alaska to Argentina. This time he cycled 21,050 km in 268 days and during the trip he also climbed the highest mountains in North and South America – McKinley and Aconcagua.

The Niagara Falls

In 1960, a little boy called Roger Woodward was in a boat. There was an accident and he fell over the Falls. He was seven years old. He was wearing only a lifejacket, a swimming costume and a pair of shoes. A tourist boat rescued him and he survived unhurt but... he lost his shoes!

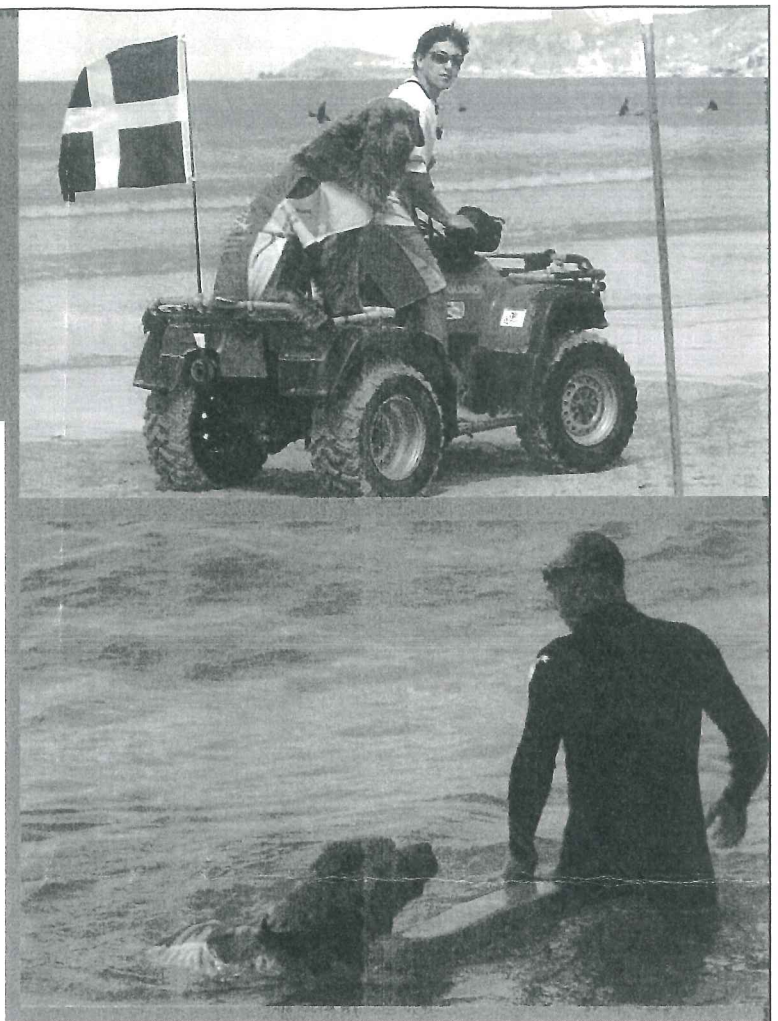
